Position Title: Food Recovery Cook

Hours: 6 -20 hours per week

This position with Cranbrook Food Recovery will help decrease food waste, increase food security and put diverted food to its highest use. Cranbrook Food Recovery partners with local grocers and bakeries to recover edible food and divert it either to local food support agencies or local farmers. This position will be responsible for using recovered ingredients to create frozen ready-to-eat community meals. This is a unique position that will allow much creativity and autonomy in the kitchen. These meals will be distributed to community partners and available to the public by donation. Shift schedules can be flexible based on availability.

The successful candidate:

- Build healthy, nutritious, and delicious menus based on inventory of recovered food
- Prepare, package, and label meals
- Lead and coordinate volunteers to support meal production
- Act as a role model for staff, volunteers, and clients
- Ensure food-safe handling procedures and practices are followed
- Ensure tracking of supplies as well as quantities of production
- Maintain a high level of kitchen organization and cleanliness

- Assist with various other food-related tasks

- Knowledge of food handling, food production and safe food handling.
- Previous experience preparing high volumes of tasty food.
- Creativity in the kitchen; comfort cooking without a recipe.

- Good oral communication skills.
- Able to lift loads of 40lbs.
