About the Role

Are you passionate about growing food and working outdoors? Join us as a Community Garden Grower at the Public Produce Garden and get hands-on experience in all aspects of food production! You'll be directly involved in planting, maintaining, and harvesting a variety of crops, while learning practical skills in gardening, soil health, and sustainable agriculture.

Key Responsibilities

Soil Preparation & Crop Maintenance

Prepare soil for planting, including tasks such as tilling, composting, and bed creation. Support ongoing crop care, including watering, weeding, thinning, and mulching.

Seeding & Harvesting

Assist with planting seeds, transplanting seedlings, and maintaining crops throughout the growing season. Help with harvesting produce when it's ready, and ensuring it gets distributed to the community from the garden or through our organization.

Garden Management

Assist with the day-to-day operations of the garden, including monitoring plant health, maintaining irrigation system, managing pests, and ensuring that crops are growing, and space is used efficiently.

Inventory Management

Keep track of garden supplies, seeds, and equipment, and report any needs for purchasing additional materials to keep the garden running smoothly.

Tool & Equipment Maintenance

Maintain and use garden tools and equipment to support daily gardening tasks, ensuring everything is in good working condition.

Record Keeping & Reporting

Track plant growth, yields, and garden outputs, and report this information to the Garden Coordinator to help evaluate garden success and productivity.

- **Gardening Interest** A strong interest in learning about plant growth, soil health, and sustainable gardening practices.
- Hands-on Work Ethic Comfort with physical outdoor work, including lifting, bending, digging, and working in varying weather conditions.

- **Problem-Solving** Identifying challenges in the garden, such as pest issues or plant health, and finding solutions to maintain productivity.
- Basic Math & Record-Keeping Basic numeracy skills to track planting schedules, harvest volumes, and inventory needs.
- Technical Skills Familiarity or willingness to learn about gardening tools, irrigation systems, and gardening techniques
