Community Connections Society is seeking a motivated individual to child mind for our Bellies to Babies and Family Resource Program.

Duties and Responsibilities:

With Support from the Registered Nurse and Outreach Worker, the child minder will provide care for children and appropriate playroom activities for children who attend the drop-in program with their parent(s). Children may range in age from one day to 10 years. Parent(s) will remain on site and continue to assist with physical needs of diapering and toileting.

Childcare worker will also be involved directly with parents who attend the Bellies to Babies drop- in programs. Worker activities may include teaching, role modeling and supporting parents in gaining parenting and child development knowledge and skills.

Qualifications:

- Relevant experience in the childcare field (minimum 2 years)
- Basic First Aid Course and CPR "C" certification
- Awareness of family issues and dynamics
- Knowledgeable of Cranbrook's social services and early childhood programs

Skills and Abilities

- Ability to work with women, their partners and children ranging from newborn to 10 years of age in a non-judgemental and confidential manner.
- Ability to deal effectively with socially marginalized groups such as teen mothers, indigenous women and substance using women.
- Ability to work as a team member and alone.
- Ability to work with individuals and/or groups.
- Basic computer skills.
- Physical abilities to carry out the duties of the position.
- Effective verbal and written communication skills.
